Conclusions on FoM and Licensing / Brussels 16 September 2014

- BGD party informed of its decision to further extend the freedom of movement arrangements to Belgrade Nikola Tesla International Airport on 22 September at 08:00 and to an additional five border crossing points in the next two months (Kelebija, Gradina, Presevo, Sid and Nis airport on November 15);
- BGD party indicated that the lay-out of customs stamps will be reviewed within one month so as to ensure the use of denomination consistent with the agreement on 17 January 2013;
- BGD party also indicated that the use of the "Kosovo" denomination in the SAD form will be reviewed;
- The parties confirmed previous conclusions reached on 17 January, 3 October, 5 November 2013 and on 9 April 2014;
- The parties in particular recalled that:
 - 1. No registration is required for companies established in northern Kosovo prior to the Agreement on Collection of Custom Duties reached on 17 January 2013:
 - 2. Licensing is only required for companies importing controlled goods;
 - 3. The documentation issued by MNAO for those companies constitutes an initial licence application, which needs to be complemented by additional documentation;
 - 4. MNAO will offer its services in accordance with para.9 of the conclusions dated 5 November 2013;
 - 5. The licensing process for controlled goods ought to be completed by 31 December 2014.
